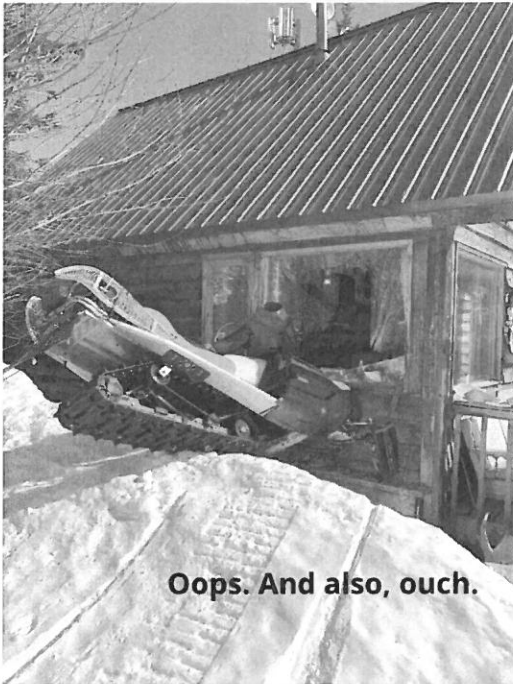

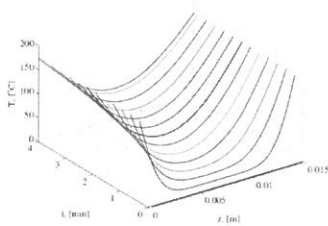
Did anyone fall for this one???

In Science:

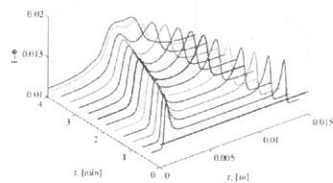
- Researchers have identified an antifreeze protein which allows fish blood to stay liquid at below freezing temperatures.
